Launching Campus MaNa in 2023 is for me giving life to a childhood dream, that of a place of creation and training around Crafts, Design and Architecture. It is to realize the dream of opening an essential destination to develop an approach to creation as a leitmotiv, where learning, practicing and creating are coming together, day after day.

It means bringing together in one place, a production center with workshops (wood, metal, ceramics, couleurs...) and a training center, to develop the largest community of creatorsin Europe.

It is basically the project of a lifetime.

I chose to place it in a preserved green setting, here it is, in Champignelles, La Puisaye, a land of creation in Burgundy.

EQUIPMENT AND WORKSHOPS

The Indoor Amphitheatre is a thousand square-meter facility built in the 2000's thanks to the support of the European Union. It hosts various events from conferences, masterclasses, and seminars. It will also be home to the Material Library, the Fab Lab, Study Rooms, and Administrative Offices.

The Materials Library offers a wide range of wood, metal, resin, fabric, stone, glass, and innovative material samples... The materials library will be updated according to innovations and trends, but also according to the needs and requests related to different courses.

The Fab Lab is a fabulous room filled with computer-assisted tools, including excellent 3D printers. Our Fab Lab will be interconnected with other fab labs around the world. Each FabLab is created to meet the needs of a community and the direction the fab lab takes is directly influenced by the community that makes it up: the Campus MaNa community that you can be part of!



YET, THE WORKSHOPS ARE THE VERY HEART OF THE CAMPUS

Wood workshop

This 400 square-meter workshop is provided with over 50 tools and machins especially made for woodworking and carpentry.

Metak workshop

This 200 square-meter space is provided with over 30 tools and machins especially made for metallurgy professions. An outdoor forge is completing the workshop.

Ceramics workshop

This 400 square-meter workshop on 2 levels is displaying spaces dedicated to casting and molding. Equipped by large workbenches, well thought, several ceramics towers, enameling cabinets and many kilns.

HOUSING

The campus has several bedrooms for one or two persons, spaceful and luminous, with carefully selected furniture to provide a maximum comfort. Each room has a working desk, its own bathroom. In the rooms, sheets and towels are at your disposal and are changed every week.

If you wish to come to Campus MaNa with a larger group, we can offer you off-site options not far from the campus.

The House of Manaïstes is a bourgeois building from the 19th–Century that has been Fully renovated and improved.

The House of Tutors, with its typical Puisaye farmhouse architecture, has been completely renovated and improved, offering spacious and bright rooms. Speakers will find high-end but simple comfort, in keeping with the environment and spirit of the campus.
